Eligibility Guidelines

You or your family will be considered if you are a documented resident of the United States and your total annual income is between 25-60% of the Greater Worcester median family income. As of May 2010, these figures are:

Family Size	Annual Income
Three	\$17,925 - \$43,020
Four	\$19,925 - \$47,820
Five	\$21,525 - \$51,660
Six	\$23,125 - \$55,500

Family Selection Criteria

The three criteria Habitat for Humanity uses to select potential partner families are:

- Need for adequate shelter
- Ability to pay for a Habitat home
- Willingness to partner with Habitat
